**Courses primarily for undergraduates:**

## **LATIN 1010: Elementary Latin I**

Credits: 3. Contact Hours: Lecture 3.

Grammar and vocabulary of classical Latin, within the context of Roman culture; reading knowledge through texts adapted from classical authors. (Typically Offered: Fall)

## **LATIN 1020: Elementary Latin II**

Credits: 3. Contact Hours: Lecture 3.

*Prereq:* LATIN 1010

Grammar and vocabulary of classical Latin, within the context of Roman culture; reading knowledge through texts adapted from classical authors. Meets International Perspectives Requirement. (Typically Offered: Spring)

## **LATIN 4900: Independent Study**

Credits: 1-6. Repeatable, maximum of 9 credits.

*Prereq:* 9 credits in LATIN; Permission of Department Chair

Designed to meet the needs of students who seek work in areas other than those in which courses are offered, or who desire to integrate a study of literature or language with special problems in major fields.

Graduation Restriction: No more than 9 credits in LATIN 4900 may be counted toward graduation.
